### SUMMARY

Roberto Cavallo is an associate professor in the Department of Architecture at the Faculty of Architecture & the Built Environment, Delft University of Technology. He currently serves as the head of the Theory, Territories, Transition section, chairman of the Architectural Design Crossovers group, and a member of the departmental research steering team. From 2014 to 2019, he was the director of education for the faculty. He completed his Ph.D. at TU Delft in 2008, obtained the IUS promovendi in 2017, and is currently supervising several Ph.D. candidates. He is a council member of the European Association of Architectural Education (EAAE) and a founding member of the Architectural Research European Network Association (ARENA). In 2013, he was a visiting professor at the Centre for Urban and Regional Studies at the Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences, as well as at the Faculty of Architecture at Hong Kong University, and in 2014 at the College of Architecture & Urban Planning at Beijing Technical University. In the academic year 2020/2021, he was a visiting professor at the Faculty of Architecture, Urban Planning and Construction Engineering, Politecnico di Milano.

His research focuses on various facets of architecture, particularly the interaction between infrastructures and urban transformations and the role of architectural interventions, linking theory with practice and education. He has extensive experience in organizing, coordinating, and leading international workshops, symposia, conferences, exhibitions, and research projects within academic and practice-oriented initiatives. He is often invited for keynote lectures and as a member of scientific committees at international academic events in the Netherlands and abroad. Since 2013, he has been a Built Environment expert at the European Commission, advising on various EU projects. Notable research projects include Snelweg & Stad (Highway & City) and Stad van de Toekomst (City of the Future), for which he obtained a research grant from the Helmut Hentrich Foundation in Düsseldorf. He is the TU Delft project leader for design-driven doctoral research projects CA2RE and CA2RE+, and he leads the Architectural Pedagogy research group in the Department of Architecture. His scientific output has had a considerable impact, with works such as "The Urban Project," "New Urban Configurations," and a special issue of the International Journal of Technology and Design Education titled "Architecture and Built Environment Design Education." He has also contributed to various international exhibitions, including the Beijing Design Week, Seoul Architecture Biennale, the Triennale di Milano, and the Venice Architecture Biennale, where he initiated, organized, and conducted a successful thematic Biennale Session in 2018. Currently, he represents the EAAE in two Horizon Europe projects linked to the New European Bauhaus, digiNEB and NEBA Alliance.

Roberto Cavallo is a key player in architectural education, with his expertise and forward-thinking highly valued at the faculty, TU Delft, and the European level. As director of education, he led a comprehensive MSc improvement plan for the faculty, achieving remarkable results in both content and performance. Under his guidance, the faculty underwent an education assessment, receiving very positive feedback from the assessment panel for all programs. Thanks to his strategy and efforts, multidisciplinary education has gained prominence within the faculty's educational portfolio. He established connections with other educational programs outside of Architecture (e.g., the MSc track in Transport, Infrastructure & Logistics, involving TU Delft faculties CiTG/TPM/3ME), contributing to several debates at the university level and bringing this subject matter to the forefront of various initiatives, conferences, and encounters at the European level. He has a comprehensive track record in leading roles in education, from setting up, content development, implementation, and renewal of educational programs to their evaluation, improvement, accreditation, and assessment. He is the initiator of the faculty-wide Research on Education Innovation program, which he leads with RR. While fulfilling many roles in education, he has built an outstanding reputation in terms of leadership that extends beyond the Department of Architecture and the faculty. He also has extensive experience in policy, planning, advising, and coaching in education and research, as well as serving on national and international commissions and workgroups. Since 1999, he has been the main graduation tutor for over 150 students. Registered as a licensed architect, he has several years of practice experience and has been appointed as an expert for the Dutch Architects Registration Bureau since 2019.
